## **Need Determination**

Application of the standard methodology for the North Carolina 2015 State Medical Facilities Plan determined the need for <u>37</u> 76 adult chemical dependency (substance abuse) beds, as shown in Table 16C below. There is no need anywhere else in the state and no other reviews are scheduled.

## REVISED – Table 16C: Adult Chemical Dependency (Substance Abuse) Residential Treatment Bed Need Determinations

(Scheduled for Certificate of Need Review Commencing in 2015)

This revision reduces the projected need in the Central Region to 12 beds from 51 beds, as previously shown in the 2015 SMFP for review beginning June 15, 2015.

It is determined that the mental health planning regions listed in the table below need additional adult chemical dependency treatment beds as specified.
