

1 10A NCAC 14D .0401 is proposed as a temporary rule as follows:

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5 **10A NCAC 14D .0401 ENROLLMENT OF RESIDENTS**

6 (a) Any adult (18 years of age or over) who, because of a physical condition or mental disability, needs a substitute
7 home for purpose of respite for the caregiver, may be enrolled for overnight respite services, when, in the opinion of
8 the caregiver or family, resident, physician, or social worker and the administrator, the services and accommodations
9 of the facility will meet the respite needs of the resident.

10 (b) Individuals shall not be admitted:

11 (1) for treatment of mental illness, or alcohol or drug abuse;

12 (2) for maternity care;

13 (3) for professional nursing care under continuous medical supervision;

14 (4) for lodging, when the personal assistance and supervision offered for the aged and disabled are not
15 needed; or

16 (5) who pose a direct threat to the health or safety of others.
