11		applicant's proposed project was submitted to the Agency, but that have not been licensed.
12	(2)	"Operating room" means a room as defined in G.S. 131E 176(18c), which includes an inpatient
13		operating room, an outpatient or ambulatory surgical operating room, or a shared operating room.
14		"Dedicated C-section operating room" means an operating room as defined in Chapter 6 in the 2018
15		State Medical Facilities Plan. For purposes of this Section, Chapter 6 in the 2018 State Medical
16		Facilities Plan is hereby incorporated by reference including subsequent amendments and editions.

21		Hospital License Renewal Application Form submitted to the Acute and Home Care Licensure and
22		Certification Section of the Division of Health Service Regulation, and that were licensed prior to

24	(4)	"Dedicated cesarean section operating room" means an operating room as defined in the applicable
25		State Medical Facilities Plan. "Health System" shall have the same meaning as defined in Chapter
26		6 in the 2018 State Medical Facilities Plan.
27	(5)	"Existing operating rooms" means those operating rooms in ambulatory surgical facilities and
28		hospitals which were reported in the License Application for Ambulatory Surgical Facilities and
29		Programs and in Part III of Hospital Licensure Renewal Application Form submitted to the Acute
30		and Home Care Licensure and Certification Section of the Division of Health Service Regulation
31		and which were licensed and certified prior to the beginning of the review period. "Operating room"
32		means a room as defined in G.S. 131E-176(18c).
33	(6)	"Approved operating rooms" means those operating rooms that were approved for a certificate of
34		need by the Certificate of Need Section prior to the date on which the applicant's proposed project
35		was submitted to the Agency but that have not been licensed. "Operating Room Need Methodology"
36		means the Methodology for Projecting Operating Room Need in Chapter 6 in the 2018 State Medical

8		(i.e., the applicant owns 50 percent or more of another company), a joint venture in which the
9		applicant is a member, or a company that shares common ownership with the applicant (i.e., the

11	(10)	"Service area" means the Operating Room Service Area as defined in the applicable State Medical
12		Facilities Plan.
13	(11)	"Shared operating room" means an operating room that is used for the performance of both
14		ambulatory and inpatient surgical procedures.
15	(12)	"Specialty area" means an area of medical practice in which there is an approved medical specialty
16		certificate issued by a member board of the American Board of Medical Specialties and includes
17		the following: gynecology, otolaryngology, plastic surgery, general surgery, ophthalmology,
18		urology, orthopedics, and oral surgery.
19	(13)	"Specialty ambulatory surgical program" means a program as defined in G.S. 131E-176(24c).
20	(14)	"Surgical case" means an individual who receives one or more surgical procedures in an operating
21		room during a single operative encounter.
