## **MEMORANDUM**

**DATE:** September 16, 2024

**TO:** Interested Parties

FROM: Shanah Black, Rule Review Manager

**RE:** Proposed Readoption of Licensing of Adult Care Homes of Seven or More Beds and

Licensing of Family Care Homes Rules 10A NCAC 13F and 10A NCAC 13G

GS 150B-21.2 requires a rule-making body to notify certain individuals of its intent to adopt a rule. It also requires notification of the date, time and location of the public hearing on the rule and any fiscal analysis that has been prepared in connection with the proposed rule. As a result of the periodic review of the rules in Subchapters 10A NCAC 13F and 10A NCAC 13G, 97 rules determined as "Necessary With Substantive Public Interest" are required to be readopted. At this time, 33 for the Licensing of Adult Care Homes of Seven or More Beds and the Licensing of Family Care Homes are proposed for readoption, 6 for amendment and 1 for repeal.

The North Carolina Medical Care Commission has submitted form OAH 0300 to the Codifier of Rules, Office of Administrative Hearings, indicating its intent to proceed with the following rule-making actions:

Approval of the fiscal analysis for these rules was obtained from the Office of State Budget and Management on April 22, 2024 in accordance with G.S. 150B-21.4. Prior to republication in the N.C. Registry, Office of State Budget and Management reaffirmed on August 22, 2024 that the fiscal analysis for the rules has not changed. OSBM approved the fiscal note upon review of the revisions.

The proposed rule text is attached to this memo. The rules were published in today's September 16, 2024 edition of the N.C. A public hearing is scheduled for October 22, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. in Room 026, Edgerton Building, 809 Ruggles Drive, Raleigh, NC 27603. The building is in the Dorothea Dix Park. Ms. Shanah Black, DHSR Rule-Review Manager, is accepting public comments on these rules and fiscal analysis from September 16, 2024 through November 15, 2024, close of business. Comments will also be accepted in person at the public hearing. The proposed effective date of these rules is as follows:

Group A: February 1, 2025 Group B: May 1, 2025 Group C: August 1, 2025
