RE: Closed or Vacant Adult Care Homes (7 or more beds)

Our agency records show that some licensed adult care homes closed for operation and have maintained the facility's license. This memorandum serves as a reminder that rule 10A NCAC 13F .0302(d) Design and Construction applies, and it states, "Any existing licensed facility that is closed or vacant for more than one year shall meet all requirements of a new facility."

If your facility has been closed or vacant for more than one year, please contact the DHSR Construction Section at the number below prior to admitting residents to the facility to ensure the facility meets current physical plant requirements.
