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Section 1310-4-05

1310-4-05.001 The Adult Care Licensing Division shall develop a mandatory annual in-service training program for adult care home medication aides on infection control, safe practices for inspections and any other procedures during which bleeding typically occurs and phlebotomy monitoring. Each medication aide who successfully completes the in-service training program shall receive partial credit, as an employer determined by the Department, toward the continuing education requirements for adult care home medication aides established by the Commission pursuant to C.S. 1310-4-05.

1310-4-05.002 This Rule is not met as evidenced by:
 Based on observations, interviews, and record reviews, the facility failed to provide mandatory annual state approved infection control training for 3 of 3 sampled staff who had been employed for more than a year.

The findings are:

Observation on 2/14/18 of Staff B at 9:30 am revealed she obtained a fingerstick blood sugar (FSBS) using proper infection control techniques on 2 separate residents.

Infection control course/training has been completed in the facility and training will be completed monthly as required by the regulations. 4/5/18

Amended POC per our conversation by telephone on 4/30/18 at 12:30 pm, with Dottie Osborne.
 All staff records will be checked every 6 months and upon hire for the completion of the required annual infection control training. The Administrator will be responsible for the staff record checks every 6 months. D. Spillman
