Objectives

- 1. Discuss the use of Personal Protective Equipment by the care worker.
- 2. Demonstrate procedures important to the prevention of infection in adult care homes donning/removing gloves, gowns, and mask.

Supplies

- Boxes of gloves in a variety of sizes
- 1 disposable gown for demonstration purposes; 2 disposable gowns per student
- 1 disposable mask for demonstration purposes; 2 disposable masks per student
- Copy paper to duplicate two activities
- Premade chocolate pudding cup
- Plastic spoon

Advance Preparation – Activities

- **#7 Glove Sizing:** Select and obtain permission to participate in activity from student with very small hands, student with very large hands, and student with average-size hands
- #8 Gloves, Gloves: Gather boxed of boxes in a variety of sizes and chocolate pudding with spoon
- #9 Gloving Check-off: For each student, duplicate a copy of the Gloving Check-off Sheet
- #10 Gowning Check-off: For each student, duplicate a copy of the Gowning Checkoff Sheet
- #11 Masking Check-off: For each student, duplicate a copy of the Masking Check-off Sheet
