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## Baptist Hospital proposes \$38.7-million ambulatory surgery building

**RALEIGH** – North Carolina Baptist Hospital has filed an application with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to construct a \$38.7-million ambulatory surgery building.

A public hearing for this project will be held at 11 a.m. on March 8, in the auditoriaum of Forsyth County Public Library, Central Branch, 660 West 5<sup>th</sup> St., Winston-Salem.

The project includes the construction of an ambulatory surgery building with eight operating rooms, two procedure rooms, a simulation operating room, and a robotic surgery training room.
