Seven compete to establish home health agency in Wake County

RALEIGH – Seven applicants have filed competing applications with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to develop a Medicare/Medicaid-certified home health agency in Wake County.

A public hearing for these competing projects will be held at 1 p.m. on June 21 at The Garner Historic Auditorium, 742 West Garner Road, Garner.

The 2010 State Medical Facilities Plan has identified the need for one additional home health agency in Wake County. The seven applicants proposing to establish a new Medicare/Medicaid certified home health agency office in Wake County are:

- SunCrest Home Health of North Carolina, Inc.
- Home Health and Hospice Care, Inc.

- Continuum II Home Care and Hospice, Inc.
