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## Clemmons Medical Park LLC proposes diagnostic imaging center

RALEIGH – Clemmons Medical Park LLC has filed an application with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to develop a diagnostic imaging facility in Clemmons.

A public hearing for this project will be held at 11 a.m. on Dec. 17 in Courtroom 5B in the Forsyth County Courthouse at 200 North Main Street in Winston-Salem.

The proposed facility, which will be called the "Clemmons Medical Park Imaging Center," will be located at 2325 Lewisville Clemmons Road in Clemmons and will offer CT scanner, ultrasound and digital x-ray imaging services. The project is expected to cost \$5.1 million. Clemmons Medical Park, LLC is owned by North Carolina Baptist Hospital and Wake Forest University Health Sciences.
