Wake Forest Ambulatory Ventures LLC proposes ambulatory surgery center

RALEIGH – Wake Forest Ambulatory Ventures LLC has filed an application with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to develop an ambulatory surgical facility in Clemmons.

A public hearing for this project will be held at 11 a.m.on Dec. 17 in Courtroom 5B in the Forsyth County Courthouse, 200 North Main St., Winston-Salem.

Wake Forest Ambulatory Ventures LLC proposes to relocate three existing operating rooms to a new multi-specialty ambulatory surgical facility in Clemmons, and develop one new procedure room. The proposed cost of the project is \$8.6 million. The proposed facility, which will be called the "*Clemmons Medical Park Ambulatory Surgery Center*," will be located at 2310 Bay Meadows Court in Clemmons.
