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Three in Triangle compete for single specialty operating rooms

RALEIGH – Three competing applications have been filed with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to develop a single specialty ambulatory surgery facility with two operating rooms in the Triangle area.

A public hearing for these projects will be held at 1 p.m. on Jan. 18, in Room 201 of the Council Building, 701 Barbour Drive on the campus of Dorothea Dix Hospital in Raleigh.

The 2010 State Medical Facilities Plan (SMFP) identifies a need for two operating rooms pursuant to a single specialty ambulatory surgery demonstration project in the Triangle area, which includes Wake, Durham and Orange counties. A brief description of each proposed project follows:

- Triangle Orthopaedics Surgery Center, LLC proposes to develop a \$2.4-million orthopedic ambulatory surgery facility with two operating rooms to be located near the intersection of ACC Boulevard and Briar Creek Parkway in Raleigh.
- Obesity Management Center of the Carolinas, LLC proposes to develop a \$5.9-million general surgery ambulatory surgery facility with two operating rooms to be located adjacent to Rex Healthcare of Cary on Cary Parkway.
- North State Surgery Center Holdings, LLC proposes to develop a \$5.5-million general surgery ambulatory surgery facility with two operating rooms to be located on Europa Drive in Chapel Hill.
