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Halifax Gastroenterology proposes to license two GI endoscopy rooms

RALEIGH – Halifax Gastroenterology has filed an application with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to obtain a license as an ambulatory surgical facility with two gastrointestinal endoscopy rooms.

A public hearing for this project will be held at 11 a.m. on Jan. 18 in the meeting room of the Roanoke Rapids Public Library, 319 Roanoke Ave., Roanoke Rapids. Members of the public may make comments concerning this proposal at that time.

The proposed ambulatory surgical facility will be located in the existing office of Dr. Nagarjuna Yerra in Roanoke Rapids. The project is expected to cost \$35,000 and to be completed by July 2011.
