Mission Hospital proposes to relocate gastrointestinal endoscopy room

RALEIGH – Mission Hospital has filed an application with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to relocate one licensed gastrointestinal (GI) endoscopy room.

A public hearing for this project will be held at 11 a.m. on May 20 at Buncombe County Public Libraries, Pack Library, Lord Auditorium (Lower Level), 67 Haywood St., Asheville.

The \$1.2-million project involves the relocation of one licensed GI endoscopy room from the Mission Hospital campus in Asheville to Mission GI South in Fletcher.
