Blessed Health and Rehab of Dunn proposes to relocate nursing facility to Angier

RALEIGH – Blessed Health and Rehab of Dunn, LLC and Dunn RE, LLC have filed an application with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to replace and relocate Blessed Health and Rehab of Dunn, a 96-bed nursing facility, from Dunn to Angier.

A public hearing for this project will be held at 11 a.m. on June 13 in the Angier Municipal Building in Angier.

The project is expected to cost \$7.7 million. The current facility was originally licensed in 1971. The new 44,084-square-foot replacement facility in Angier will be approximately 17 miles from the current site in Dunn. The project is expected to be complete Nov. 1.
