90-bed nursing facility proposed in Huntersville, Mecklenburg County

RALEIGH – An application filed with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation seeks to develop a 90-bed nursing facility in Huntersville, Mecklenburg County. The proposed capital cost of the project is \$11.2 million.

Charlotte Health Care Center, 68 Inc. and others propose to develop a new nursing facility by relocating 60 approved but undeveloped beds and 30 existing beds from the Charlotte Health Care Center to a new site in Huntersville.

A public hearing for this project will be held at 12:30 p.m. on July 14, in Room 267 (2nd Floor) of the Charlotte Mecklenburg Government Center at 600 East 4th St., Charlotte.
