Two compete for 10 dialysis stations in Northampton County

RALEIGH – DVA Healthcare Renal Care, Inc and Bio-Medical Applications of North Carolina, Inc. have filed competing applications with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to develop up to 10 dialysis stations in Northampton County.

The applications are in response to a county need cetermination identified in the July 2011 Semi-Annual Dialysis Report. A public hearing for these projects will be held on Nov. 14 at 10 a.m. in the Commissioners Room of the County Office Building, 100 West Jefferson St., in Jackson.

The two applications are as follows:

- DVA Healthcare Renal Care Inc, proposes to develop a new 10-station dialysis facility, the Northampton Dialysis Center, in Garysburg. The proposed project has a total capital cost of \$1,177,548.
- Bio-Medical Applications of North Carolina Inc, proposes to add three dialysis stations to its existing FMC East Northampton Center for a total of 19 dialysis stations, in Conway. The proposed project has a total capital cost of \$59,640.
