Five compete for home health agency in Wake County

RALEIGH – Five applicants have filed competing proposals with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to develop a home health agency in Wake County.

A public hearing for these projects will be held at 10 a.m. on June 11 at the Garner Historic Auditorium, 742 West Garner Road, Garner.

The 2012 State Medical Facilities Plan has identified a need for one additional home health agency in Wake County. Each of the five proposals seek to develop a Medicare-certified home health agency in Wake County. The providers and their anticipated project costs are as follows:

- Hillcrest Home Health of the Triangle, \$98,900.
- HealthKeeperz of Wake, \$62,400.
- AssistedCare of the Carolinas, \$31,874.
- Maxim Healthcare Services, \$50,000.
- Oakland Home Care, \$143,819.
