DaVita to develop 16-station kidney disease treatment center in Henderson

RALEIGH – DaVita Healthcare Renal Care, Inc. d/b/a Kerr Lake Dialysis has filed an application with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to develop a sixteen station kidney disease treatment center in Henderson by relocating sixteen stations from Vance County Dialysis.

A public hearing for this project will be held at 11 a.m. on June 20 in the Board Room in the H. Leslie Perry Memorial Library, 205 Breckenridge St., Henderson.

The project is expected to cost \$1.7 million and to be complete in January 2015.
