Total Renal Care of North Carolina to develop 18-station kidney disease treatment center in Jacksonville

RALEIGH – Total Renal Care of North Carolina, LLC d/b/a New River Dialysis has filed an application with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to develop an 18-station kidney disease treatment center in Jacksonville by relocating 18 stations from Southeastern Dialysis Center-Jacksonville.

A public hearing for this project will be held at 11 a.m. on June 17 at the Onslow County Public Library, 58 Doris Ave. East, Jacksonville.

The project is expected to cost \$1.7 million and is expected to be complete by January 2015.
