WakeMed asks to convert Fuquay-Varina and Zebulon nursing home beds to hospital beds and relocate them to WakeMed North

RALEIGH – WakeMed has filed an application with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to convert 16 nursing home beds to hospital beds and relocate the beds to WakeMed North Healthplex. Thirteen of the nursing home beds are at WakeMed Zebulon/Wendell and three of the nursing home beds are at WakeMed Fuquay-Varina.

A public hearing for this project will be held at 2 p.m. on Oct. 18 in Room 104 of the Brown Building on the Dorothea Dix Campus, 801 Biggs Drive, Raleigh.

The project is expected to cost \$6.5 million and to be complete in October 2015.
