DVA Healthcare proposes the development of a new 10-station dialysis facility

RALEIGH – DVA Healthcare Renal Care, Inc. has filed an application with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to develop a new 10-station dialysis facility in Durham to be known as East Durham Dialysis.

A public hearing for this project will be held at 10:00 a.m. on June 17 in Room 104 of the Brown Building, 801 Biggs Drive, Raleigh, N.C. (Dorothea Dix Campus).

The applicant proposes to transfer seven stations from Durham Dialysis and three stations from West Durham Dialysis to develop the new End Stage Renal Disease (ESRD) facility in East Durham. The project is expected to cost \$2,287,605.
