Veritas proposes 25-bed hospital in Durham for adults with eating disorders

RALEIGH – Veritas Collaborative, LLC has filed an application with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to develop a 25-bed specialty behavioral health hospital for adult male and female eating disorder patients at 2812 Erwin Road, Durham.

The 2014 State Medical Facilities Plan identifies a need in North Carolina for 25 beds to serve adult male and female patients with identified eating disorders as classified in the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders, such as anorexia nervosa, bulimia nervosa and binge-eating disorder.

A public hearing for this project will be held at 2 p.m. on Aug. 20 in the Haywood Gym on the Dorothea Dix Campus at 805 Ruggles Drive, Raleigh.

The project is expected to cost \$9.1 million and to be complete in January 2018.
