Fresenius asks to develop dialysis facility in Tarboro

RALEIGH – Fresenius Medical Care has filed an application with the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency) to develop a 10-station end stage renal disease facility in Tarboro by relocating dialysis stations from BMA East Rocky Mount and Greenville Dialysis Center.

A public hearing for this project will be held May 18 at 10 a.m.in the Pender Room of the Edgecombe County Memorial Library, 909 N. Main St., Tarboro.

The project is expected to cost \$1.7 million and to be complete in December 2016.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Agency no later than 5:30 p.m. on May 1.
