## UNC Hospitals proposes to add 42 acute care beds

**RALEIGH** – UNC Hospitals filed an application with the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to add 42 acute care beds on the UNC Hospitals' Chapel Hill campus.

The 2015 State Medical Facilities Plan identified a need for 46 additional acute care inpatient beds in Orange County.

A public hearing for this project will be held June 16 at 9:30 a.m. in Room 104 of the Brown Building on the Dorothea Dix Campus, 801 Biggs Drive, Raleigh.

The project is expected to cost \$17 million and to be complete in June 2018.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Agency no later than 5:30 p.m. on June 1.
