Harnett Health Proposes to Acquire a Linear Accelerator

RALEIGH – Harnett Health System, Inc. has filed an application with the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section of DHHS' Division of Health Service Regulation to acquire a linear accelerator and a CT simulator, which will develop a comprehensive cancer center at Central Harnett Hospital.

A public hearing for this project will be held Oct. 20 at 11:00 a.m. in Activity Room 2 of the Lillington Community Center, 607 South 13th St., Lillington. A need for a linear accelerator for Harnett County is determined in the 2015 State Medical Facilities Plan.

The project is expected to cost \$12 million and to be complete in Oct. 2018.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Agency no later than 5:30 p.m. on Oct. 1.
