Total Renal Care proposes to add four dialysis stations to Maxton Dialysis

RALEIGH – Total Renal Care of North Carolina has filed an application with the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section of DHHS' Division of Health Service Regulation to add four dialysis stations to a new dialysis facility to be developed in Maxton by relocating four dialysis stations from Dialysis Care of Hoke County in Raeford. Upon completion of the project, the Maxton Dialysis facility would operate 14 dialysis stations.

A public hearing for this project will be held Nov. 17 at 1 p.m. in the Commissioners Meeting Room at the Robeson County Administration Building, 701 North Elm St., Lumberton.

The project is expected to cost \$71,000 and to be complete in January 2017.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Agency no later than 5:30 p.m. on Nov. 2.
