Novant Health seeks to expand Huntersville Medical Center

RALEIGH – Novant Health has filed an application with the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section of DHHS' Division of Health Service Regulation to expand its Novant Health Huntersville Medical Center. Expansion would be by relocating 48 acute care beds and one operating room from Novant Health Presbyterian Medical Center.

Upon completion of the proposal Novant Health Huntersville Medical Center would be licensed for 139 acute care beds and six operating rooms. A public hearing for this project will be held on Dec. 17 at 9 a.m. in room 270/271 of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Government Center, 600 E. 4th St., Charlotte.

The project is expected to cost \$44.6 million.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5:30 p.m. on Dec. 1.
