Novant Health seeks approval for ambulatory surgery facility in Kernersville

RALEIGH – Novant Health has filed a Certificate of Need application with the N.C. Department of Health and Human Services to relocate two existing operating rooms from Novant Health Forsyth Medical Center in Winston-Salem to develop a new freestanding ambulatory surgery center on the campus of Novant Health Kernersville Medical Center in Kernersville. This project is expected to cost \$9.8 million and be completed in April 2018.

A public hearing for this project will be held May 12, 2016 at 11 a.m. in the Lower Level Conference Room of the Forsyth County Public Library, Kernersville Branch, 130 E. Mountain Street, Kernersville.
