## Two compete to develop dental surgical facility serving eastern North Carolina

**RALEIGH** – Two applicants have filed competing Certificate of Need applications with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to develop a dental outpatient surgical facility in Greenville or Fayetteville.

The 2016 State Medical Facilities Plan identifies a need for one dental surgical facility to serve Region 3: <u>HSA</u> <u>V and HSA VI</u>, which include Anson, Beaufort, Bertie, Bladen, Brunswick, Camden, Carteret, Chowan, Columbus, Craven, Cumberland, Currituck, Dare, Duplin, Edgecombe, Gates, Greene, Halifax, Harnett, Hertford, Hoke, Hyde, Jones, Lenoir, Martin, Montgomery, Moore, Nash, New Hanover, Northampton, Onslow, Pamlico, Pasquotank, Pender, Perquimans, Pitt, Richmond, Robeson, Sampson, Scotland, Tyrrell, Washington, Wayne, and Wilson counties. The proposals are as follows:

- Surgical Center for Dental Professionals of Greenville proposes to develop a facility with two operating rooms and two procedure rooms in Greenville. The project is expected to cost \$3.6 million and to be completed in October 2017.
- Valleygate Dental Surgery Center of Fayetteville proposes to develop a facility with two operating rooms and two procedure rooms in Fayetteville. The project is expected to cost \$4.8 million and to be completed in October 2017.

Two public hearings for these projects will be held:

- June 13, 2016 at 2:30 p.m. in the Cliffdale Meeting Room, Cliffdale Regional Branch Library, 6882 Cliffdale Road, Fayetteville.
- June 17<sup>th</sup>, 2016 at 1 p.m. in the Eugene James Auditorium on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Pitt County Administrative Office Building, 1717 West 5<sup>th</sup> St., Greenville.

Anyone may file written comments concerning the proposals. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5:30 p.m. on May 31.
