Raleigh Orthopaedic seeks to develop an ambulatory surgery center in west Cary

RALEIGH – Raleigh Orthopaedic has filed a Certificate of Need application with the N.C. Department of Health and Human Services to develop an ambulatory surgery center in west Cary with one operating room and two procedure rooms. The operating room will be moved from Raleigh Orthopaedic Surgery.

A public hearing for this project will be held June 16 at 1:00 p.m. in Conference Room 026 in the Edgerton Building, Dix Campus located at 809 Ruggles Drive in Raleigh.

The project is expected to cost \$9.5 million and to be complete in January, 2018.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5:30 p.m. on May 31.
