Novant Asks to Develop Multi-Specialty Ambulatory Surgical Center in Clemmons

RALEIGH, N.C. – Novant Health Clemmons Outpatient Surgery has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to develop a new ambulatory surgery center in Clemmons by relocating two operating rooms from Novant Health Forsyth Medical Center and adding one procedure room.

The project is expected to cost \$13.2 million and be complete in July 2019.

A public hearing for this project will be held April 18 at 1 p.m. in the Novant Health Conference Center, Executive Hall, on the first floor of Novant Health Forsyth Medical Center, 3333 Silas Creek Parkway, Winston-Salem.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5:30 p.m. March 31.
