Total Renal Care Seeks Approval for Dialysis Facility in Whitakers

RALEIGH — Total Renal Care of North Carolina, LLC doing business as Whitakers Dialysis has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services seeking approval to relocate 10 dialysis stations from Dialysis Care of Edgecombe County to develop a 10-station dialysis facility in Whitakers.

Whitakers Dialysis proposes to develop the 3,886 square foot facility at 111 SE Railroad St. in Whitakers. In addition to in-center dialysis, Whitakers Dialysis proposes to offer home hemodialysis and peritoneal dialysis training and support. The project is expected to cost \$1.9 million and would be completed in January 2020.

A public hearing for the project will be held May 21 at 11 a.m. in the Pender Room, Edgecombe County Memorial Library, 909 N. Main St. in Tarboro.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5:30 p.m. on May 1.
