Duke University Health System and Associated Health Services, Inc., Propose New Ambulatory Surgical Center

RALEIGH — Duke University Health System and Associated Health Services, Inc., are proposing to relocate four surgical operating rooms from James E. Davis Ambulatory Center to develop an ambulatory surgical center called Arringdon Ambulatory Surgical Center in southern Durham County.

The project is expected to cost \$34.2 million and would be completed in July 2020.

A public hearing for this project will be held June 19 at 9 a.m. in the Edgerton Building, Dorothea Dix Campus, 809 Ruggles Drive, Room 026 in Raleigh.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5:30 p.m. on May 31.
