## **Five Compete for Operating Rooms in Forsyth County**

RALEIGH – Five applicants have filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to develop operating rooms in response to a need determination in the 2018 State Medical Facilities Plan for four new operating rooms in Forsyth County.

The proposals are as follows:

- Triad Center for Surgery, LLC proposes to develop a new ambulatory surgical facility with two operating rooms and three procedure rooms. The project is expected to cost \$7.2 million and would be completed in January 2021.
- The Moses H. Cone Memorial Hospital and MC Kernersville, LLC propose to develop an ambulatory surgical facility with two operating rooms, one gastroenterology endoscopy room and one procedure room. The project is expected to cost \$12.7 million and would be completed in April 2020.
- Novant Health, Inc. and Forsyth Memorial Hospital, Inc. propose to add two operating rooms on the Forsyth Memorial Hospital campus for a total of 35 operating rooms. The project is expected to cost \$4.2 million and would be completed in April 2021.
- Novant Health, Inc. and Novant Health Clemmons Outpatient Surgery, LLC propose to add two operating rooms to the Novant Health Clemmons Outpatient Surgery facility for a total of four operating rooms. The project is expected to cost \$3.1 million and would be completed in April 2020.
- North Carolina Baptist Hospital proposes to add four operating rooms for a total of 51 operating rooms. The project is expected to cost \$10 million and would be completed in July 2024.

A public hearing for these projects will be held July 16 at noon in the Municipal Council Chambers of the Kernersville Town Hall, 134 East Mountain St., Kernersville.

Anyone may file written comments concerning these proposals. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5:30 p.m. on July 2.
