RALEIGH — A certificate of need public hearing scheduled for 10 a.m. on March 18 in Conference Room 26 in the Edgerton Building, Dorothea Dix Campus, 809 Ruggles Drive, Raleigh has been canceled.

The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section of the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services canceled the hearing after Bio-Medical Applications of North Carolina, Inc. withdrew its request to hold a public hearing for a certificate of need application to develop Downtown Raleigh Dialysis by relocating 10 existing dialysis stations from Wake Forest Dialysis Center.
