Public Hearing Canceled Regarding Application to Increase Home Hemodialysis Training and Support Services in Carteret County

RALEIGH — A certificate of need public hearing scheduled for 3 p.m. on March 19 in the Commissioners Room of the Carteret County Courthouse, 302 Courthouse Square, Beaufort, has been canceled.

The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section of the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services canceled the hearing after Total Renal Care of North Carolina, LLC withdrew its request for a public hearing for a certificate of need application to relocate two dialysis stations from Crystal Coast Dialysis Unit in Morehead City to FMC Sea Spray in Cedar Point to be used for home hemodialysis training and support services only.
