## Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority Seeks Approval for a New Hospital in Harrisburg

CONCORD, N.C. — The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to develop a new satellite hospital in Cabarrus County in Harrisburg — Atrium Health Harrisburg — by relocating 24 acute care beds and one operating room from Atrium Health Cabarrus and by replacing and relocating one fixed magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) scanner from Atrium Health MRI.

The project is expected to cost \$85.8 million and would be completed in December 2025.

A public hearing for this project will be held Oct. 17 at 10 a.m. in the auditorium of the Cabarrus County Library, 27 Union St. N, Concord, N.C. 28025.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5 p.m. on Oct. 3.
