Applicant Seeks Approval for New Linear Accelerator in Mecklenburg County

CHARLOTTE, N.C. – The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to develop a second linear accelerator in a medical office building on the campus of Atrium Health Pineville.

The project is expected to cost \$11.9 million and would be completed in October 2024.

A public hearing for this project will be held Oct. 20 at 10 a.m. in the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Government Center-Room 280, 600 E. 4th St. in Charlotte.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5 p.m. on Oct. 3.
