Approval Sought for Cost Overrun to Develop Satellite Emergency Department

RALEIGH – The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services for a cost overrun for previously approved Project ID #F-12088-21, to develop a satellite emergency department – Atrium Health Ballantyne – in Charlotte, Mecklenburg County.

The project is expected to cost an additional \$7.3 million, for a total of \$16.7 million, and would be completed in Jan 2024.

A public hearing for this project will be held Dec. 8 at 11:30 a.m. in Community Room B of the Allegra Westbrooks Regional Library, 2412 Beatties Ford Road, Charlotte.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5 p.m. on Dec. 1.
