PUBLIC NOTICE

Two Hospital Systems Compete for Acute Care Beds in Mecklenburg County

RALEIGH — Two hospital systems have filed certificate of need applications with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to develop acute care beds in response to a need determination in the 2022 State Medical Facilities Plan for 65 acute care beds in Mecklenburg County. The two hospital systems propose a total of four projects.

Atrium Health proposes three projects:

- Atrium Health Pineville proposes to develop 11 additional acute care beds at its existing hospital in Charlotte. The project is expected to cost \$7.5 million and would be completed in January 2025.
- Carolinas Medical Center proposes to develop 38 additional acute care beds at its existing hospital in Charlotte. The project is expected to cost \$62.7 million and would be completed in April 2027.
- Atrium Health University City proposes to develop 16 additional acute care beds at its existing hospital in Charlotte. The project is expected to cost \$8.7 million and would be completed in June 2025.

Novant Health proposes one project:

- Novant Health Presbyterian Medical Center proposes to develop 30 additional acute care beds at its existing hospital in Charlotte. The project is expected to cost \$110,000 and would be completed in September 2023.

A public hearing for these projects will be held Dec. 16 at 10 a.m. in room 270 of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Government Center, 600 E. Fourth St., in Charlotte.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5 p.m. on Dec. 1.
