Approval Sought for a Replacement 100-Bed Nursing Facility in Cleveland County

SHELBY, N.C. — Peak Resources-Shelby has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to develop a replacement facility for its existing 100-bed nursing facility. The replacement facility will be located in Grover, N.C.

The project is expected to cost \$17.8 million and would be completed in October 2024.

A public hearing for this project will be held April 17 at 10 a.m. in the Brownie Plaster Meeting Room of the Eugenia H. Young Memorial Library, 104 Howie Drive in Shelby.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5 p.m. on March 31.
