Approval Sought for a Cost Overrun to Develop a New Acute Care Hospital in Mecklenburg County

CHARLOTTE — The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services for a cost overrun for a new acute care hospital in Cornelius.

The project is expected to cost \$75.5 million and would be completed in July 2025.

A public hearing for this project will be held April 19 at noon at the Allegra Westbrooks Regional Library, Room B, 2412 Beatties Ford Road in Charlotte.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5 p.m. on March 31.
