Approval Sought for Fixed MRI Scanner in Lenoir County

KINSTON, N.C. – UNC LCI, LLC has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to acquire a fixed MRI scanner in response to a need determination in the 2024 State Medical Facilities Plan. The fixed MRI scanner would be located at UNC Lenoir Imaging in Kinston.

The project is expected to cost \$6.09 million and would be completed in Jan. 2026.

A public hearing for this project will be held August 19 at 1:30 p.m. in the Auditorium of the Kinston-Lenoir County Public Library, 510 N. Queen St. in Kinston.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5 p.m. on July 31.
