Approval Sought for 120-Bed Adult Care Home in Mecklenburg County

CHARLOTTE — Waltonwood Mecklenburg LLC has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to develop a new adult care home — Waltonwood Mecklenburg — by relocating 120 adult care home beds, including a 30-bed special care unit, from Queen City Assisted Living.

The project is expected to cost \$69.3 million and would be completed in November 2027.

A public hearing for this project will be held April 15 at 10:30 a.m. in the Randolph Room of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Library, Allegra Westbrook Regional Branch, 2412 Beatties Ford Road in Charlotte.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5 p.m. on April 1.
