Approval Sought for a Photon-Counting CT Scanner in Mecklenburg County

CHARLOTTE — Carolinas Physicians Network Inc. has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to acquire a photon-counting CT scanner to be located at Atrium Health Imaging — Kenilworth Diagnostic Center in Charlotte.

The project is expected to cost \$5.1 million and would be completed in October 2025.

A public hearing for this project will be held June 18 at 11:30 a.m. in the Randolph Room of the Charlotte Mecklenburg Library, Allegra Westbrooks Regional Branch, 2412 Beatties Ford Road in Charlotte.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5 p.m. on May 31.
