## **Approval Sought for Dialysis Facility in Wake County**

**RALEIGH** — Total Renal Care of North Carolina LLC has filed a Certificate of Need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to develop a new 10-station end stage renal disease facility in Raleigh – Tarheel Place Dialysis – by relocating dialysis stations from Wake Forest Dialysis and Oak City Dialysis.

A public hearing for this project will be held Nov. 18 at 10 a.m. in room 26 of the Edgerton Building, Dorothea Dix Campus, 809 Ruggles Drive in Raleigh.

The project is expected to cost \$3.3 million and would be completed in January 2027.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Agency no later than 5 p.m. on Oct. 31.
