Approval Sought for Fixed MRI Scanner in Alamance County

Mebane, N.C. – Duke University Health System Inc. has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services in response to a need determination in the 2025 State Medical Facilities Plan to acquire one fixed MRI scanner to be located at a diagnostic center in Mebane – Duke Imaging Mebane.

The project is expected to cost \$7 million and would be completed in July 2026.

A public hearing for this project will be held April 15 at 2 p.m. in the Meeting Room of the Mebane Public Library, 101 S. 1st St. in Mebane.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5 p.m. on March 31.
