## **Three Applicants Compete for Fixed PET Scanner**

**WINSTON-SALEM, N.C.** — Three applicants have filed certificate of need applications with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to acquire a fixed PET scanner in response to a need determination in the 2025 State Medical Facilities Plan for one fixed PET scanner in Health Service Area II.

## The applicants propose:

- The Moses H. Cone Memorial Hospital and The Moses H. Cone Memorial Hospital Operating Corporation propose to acquire one fixed PET scanner to be located at Cone Health Steven D. Bell Family Heart & Vascular Center in Greensboro. The project is expected to cost \$3.1 million and would be completed in October 2026.
- Forsyth Memorial Hospital Inc. and Novant Health Inc. propose to acquire one fixed PET scanner to be located at Novant Health Kernersville Medical Center in Kernersville. The project is expected to cost \$7.9 million and would be completed in January 2027.
- High Point Regional Health proposes to acquire one fixed PET scanner to be located at Atrium Health Wake Forest Baptist High Point Medical Center in Greensboro. The project is expected to cost \$5.9 million and would be completed in July 2027.

A public hearing for these projects will be held August 18 at 10 a.m. in the auditorium of Central Library, 660 W. 5th St. in Winston-Salem.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5 p.m. on July 31.
