RE: Request for No Review Determination Regarding Duke Medicine Specialty Care Page Road Acquisition of Medical Diagnostic Equipment / Durham County / Project I.D. #J-8613-10 / FID #101140

## Dear Ms. Meymandi:

The purpose of this letter is to inform the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Health Service Regulation, Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section (the "Agency") that Private Diagnostic Clinic, PLLC (PDC) plans to acquire medical diagnostic equipment, which will be located in its Duke Medicine Specialty Care Page Road Diagnostic Center (FID #101140).<sup>1</sup>

PDC requests the Agency to confirm that acquisition of the following medical diagnostic equipment for the Duke Medicine Specialty Care Page Road diagnostic center is non-reviewable because it does not constitute a new institutional health service. Under North Carolina law, the acquisition of medical diagnostic equipment for an existing diagnostic center is not subject to CON review unless it qualifies as "major medical equipment" under the statute. To qualify as "major medical equipment," the cost of acquiring each piece of medical diagnostic equipment would need to exceed \$750,000. PDC does not intend to acquire any equipment which exceeds this threshold.

The table on the following page summarizes the cost to acquire each piece of medical diagnostic equipment. There will be no renovation or upfit costs required to make the identified equipment operational.
